

About Holland Landing

Holland Landing, originally known as St. Albans, was founded by Governor John Graves Simcoe in 1793 as a strategic portage between York (Toronto) and Georgian Bay. Named after Samuel Holland, the settlement became the northernmost point of Yonge Street and was envisioned as an inland port linking Lake Simcoe to the Great Lakes. Though never fulfilling this role, it briefly served steamboats in the mid-1800s. Settled in the early 19th century by Quakers and others, it was home to Samuel Lount of the 1837 Rebellion. A canal project begun in 1906 was abandoned in 1912, leaving the "Ghost Canal." Today, visitors can explore Anchor Park, the Holland River, and enjoy a welcoming community that blends rich history with vibrant modern living.
